Introduction

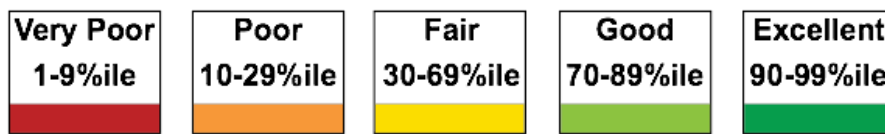
Verbal comprehension is the ability to understand and logically work through concepts and problems expressed in words. This test assesses how well a candidate can extract and work with meaning, information and implications from text.

This report is confidential and is intended solely for the person responsible for assessing Sam Sample , who completed the Verbal Comprehension on 16/11/2022.

The contents of this report are likely to be valid for 18 to 24 months.

Interpreting Scores

Scores on Verbal Comprehension are calculated by comparing an individual's score with a large group of people (norm group) who have also completed the same tests. Thus, the results are shaped by a meaningful comparison with others. These are then expressed as 'percentiles' and you can use the below scoring key to benchmark Sam's results:
